

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When is the registration deadline?

All rates posted in this registration booklet are “Early Bird” registration rates. Register by August 24th to be entered in the drawing to win a full refund of your registration rates. Enjoy reduced registration rates if you register by August 31st. Rates will increase by \$50 September 1st.

Can I register at the door?

Yes; however, you will pay higher registration rates than you would if you register prior to September 1st.

Are the lunches included in my registration?

Yes, all three lunches are included in your registration. PLEASE NOTE: While the Judicial Luncheon is intended to honor all members of the Judiciary, it is open to all registrants and not just intended for members of the Judiciary.

If I am bringing a guest, can he/she attend the social events with me?

Yes. Guest registration is available for a flat fee of \$75. This is all-inclusive, and your guest can attend all of the social events or just the ones he/she chooses for that flat fee.

Can I purchase tickets to individual social events?

No; social events are included in the Annual Meeting registration or you may purchase an all-inclusive guest registration which includes all social events.

Because CLE materials are in an electronic format, will there be an adequate power supply for my laptop in the CLE programs?

While there will be a few areas where you can recharge your laptop, you will need to rely on your battery supply as much as possible. We strongly recommend that you bring an extra battery. Keep in mind that you will also have the option of printing your materials from the Bar’s website prior to arriving at the Annual Meeting & Judicial Conference.

Is there an option to purchase CLE materials in a print copy?

No; CLE materials are only offered on a flash drive. However, you will have the option of printing your materials from the Bar’s website prior to arriving at the Annual Meeting & Judicial Conference.
