**AMENDED COURT SECURITY ORDER**

THIS MATTER having come before the Court upon its own motion; and, the Court finds that its should adopt a policy concerning Court Security on the premises of the District Court of the Ninth Judicial District within and for the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming; and, the Court being advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective immediately, **none** of the following items may be brought or carried onto the premises of the District Court of the Ninth Judicial District within and for the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, without prior approval of the presiding District Court Judge or Commissioner, to-wit:

1. Cellular telephones;
2. Personal electronic or digital audio or video recording or playing devices (Such devices approved by the presiding District Court Judge or Commissioner and/or which are strictly for use at any trial, hearing or appearance are excepted); or,
3. Devices capable of capturing, storing, playing, displaying, transmitting, receiving, saving, or downloading any visual and/or audio depiction, recording, transmission, signal, or message (Such devices approved by the presiding District Court Judge or Commissioner and/or which are strictly for use at any trial, hearing or appearance are excepted).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, effective immediately, **none** of the following items may be brought or carried onto the premises of the District Court of the Ninth Judicial District within and for the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, without prior approval of the presiding District Court Judge or Commissioner, and all such items shall be immediately confiscated (and disposed of in the discretion of Court Security Officers), and the offender may be subject to sanctions for contempt of court, as well as civil and criminal penalties, to-wit:

4. Destructive devices;
5. Stun devices, which are defined to include, but are not limited to, stun guns, pepper sprays or other sprays which are calculated to stun or render unconscious or retard the reaction of any person or other living thing, or chemicals calculated to stun or render unconscious or retard the reaction of any person or other living thing;
6. Firearms, which are defined include, but are not limited to, guns, pistols, rifles, shotguns, automatics, black powder guns, BB guns, pellet guns, or any other device capable of discharging or firing or propelling any item from such device;
7. Ammunition for firearms;
8. Deadly weapons, which are defined to include, but are not limited to, any item deemed by Court Security Officers to constitute a deadly or dangerous weapon, explosive or incendiary material, knives, items or instruments having a knife blade, letter openers, scissors (other than having rounded ends), boxcutters, needles (unless prescribed by a license practitioner), knitting or crochet needles, bows and arrows, swords, spears, clubs, or any other device or instrument or item or chemical or spray which is capable of inflicting serious injury or death to any person or other living thing or which in the manner it is used or is intended to be used is capable of producing death or serious injury to any person or other living thing;
9. Alcoholic or malt beverages; or,
10. Controlled substances not prescribed by a licensed practitioner, narcotics not prescribed by a licensed practitioner, illicit substances, or paraphernalia not prescribed by a licensed practitioner associated with the manufacture or use of any controlled substance, narcotic, or illicit substance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, effective immediately, any person who is, or who appears to be, under the influence, to any degree, of any alcoholic beverage, malt beverage, controlled substance not prescribed by a licensed practitioner, narcotic not prescribed by a licensed practitioner, or illicit substance:

11. Will not be permitted entry upon the premises of District Court of the Ninth Judicial District within and for the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming;
12. May be taken into immediate custody by Court Security Officers and/or law enforcement officers and be held until such time as the offender can be brought before the presiding District Court Judge or Commissioner;
13. May be required to submit to testing of the offender's breath or urine at the request of Court Security Officers and/or law enforcement officers; and,
14. May be subject to sanctions for contempt of court, as well as civil and criminal penalties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court's Security Officers are excepted from the prohibitions contained in paragraphs numbered 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, and 8 hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any Peace Officer, as defined and authorized by Wyoming law, who are acting in an official capacity and who are not parties to a case currently before the Court, after certifying to such and after fully disclosing to this Court's Security Officers the nature of any items which are prohibited herein in their possession, are excepted from the prohibitions contained in paragraphs numbered 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, and 8 hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that exceptions to this Court Security Order may be granted on an individual basis by this Court's Security Officers, with the approval of the presiding District Court Judge or Commissioner.
