**CIVIL CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER**

Being fully informed in the premises, the Court hereby orders that the following schedule will be observed in this matter:

1. Plaintiffs shall designate experts by.
2. Defendants shall designate experts by.
3. All other additional witnesses shall be designated by.
4. Discovery and all trial depositions shall be completed by.
5. All pretrial dispositive motions, motions in limine and Daubert motions with supporting materials, shall be filed and served by.
6. Responsive briefs and supporting materials shall be filed and served by .
7. Counsel shall meet no later than, and jointly prepare and forward to the Court by, a report containing the following:
  - a. Stipulated list of exhibits, which have been identified and marked.
  - b. Witness lists, with an indication as to will call/may call status.
  - c. Stipulated jury instructions. **THIS MAY SIMPLY BE LIST OF PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS, PLUS COPIES OF NON-PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS, WITH CITATION TO AUTHORITY.**
  - d. Stipulated verdict form.
  - e. Stipulations as to the use at trial of particular depositions and video depositions, plus the appropriate editing thereof, if necessary, and requested rulings on objections contained therein.
  - f. Counsel shall also exchange all proposed jury instructions.

8. Pretrial memoranda setting forth the issues of the case, non-stipulated jury instructions and any pretrial matters needing resolution shall be submitted to

the Court no later than. Proposed jury instructions should be submitted to the judge, rather than filed with the Clerk. **THIS MAY SIMPLY BE A LIST OF PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS, PLUS COPIES OF NON-PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS, WITH CITATION TO AUTHORITY.** Pretrial memoranda shall also include specific objections to opposing parties jury instructions.

9. A pretrial conference shall be held on, at a.m., in the District Courtroom, County Courthouse, Wyoming. The attorney who will try the case must attend the pretrial conference.

10. The jury/bench trial to last approximately five days shall begin at a.m., at the District Courtroom, County Courthouse, Wyoming.
