**STANDARD SUPERVISED PROBATION CONDITIONS**

- A) **Within 2 business days** of the date of this hearing or upon release from custody, if presently incarcerated, **prior to 4:00 p.m.**, the Defendant shall contact:
  - Wyoming Probation & Parole, 79 Winston Dr., Suite 208, Rock Springs, WY, (307)382-4513
  - Wyoming Probation & Parole, 140 Commerce Drive, Suite A, Green River, WY, (307)875-2030
  - Sweetwater County D.U.I. Supervised Probation (DSP) office located in the Rock Springs Circuit Court Bldg, 731 C Street, Rock Springs, WY, (307)922-5274,
- B) The Defendant shall have no violations of any state, federal, or local law. The Defendant will report any new citations or arrests to the supervising probation agent immediately.
- C) The Defendant shall obey all the rules and regulations of the probation agent including all conditions of the Probation Agreement, and reporting for appointments as instructed.
- D) The Defendant shall not leave the State of Wyoming without prior approval of the supervising probation agent and not before securing a written travel pass.
- E) The Defendant will allow the supervising probation agent to visit her/his home, employment site or elsewhere the Defendant may be for routine home visit or other matters related to supervision of the case.
- F) The Defendant shall be subject to search and seizure of his/her person, vehicle, residence or other area he/she may be occupying whenever the supervising agent has reason to believe said Defendant has violated the conditions of the Judgment and Sentence.
- G) The Defendant shall keep the supervising agent advised of his/her current address, phone number and living arrangements. Any changes will be reported to the supervising agent within 24 hours of the occurrence. The Defendant shall maintain a telephone at his/her residence unless reason can be shown to your supervising agent why such service is not available.
- H) **Any proof of completion of an evaluation, program ordered, or any releases needed for this probation shall be provided to your supervising agent instead of the County Attorney's Office.**

**THE BELOW CONDITIONS ARE ONLY APPLICABLE IF MARKED**

- \_\_\_\_\_ I) The Defendant shall make regular monthly payments in an amount to be determined by the supervising agent towards any monies owed to the court (Including restitution, Crime Victims Compensation Fund, court costs, fines (including unpaid fines from previous offenses), Public Defender charges and DSP fees). Said payments shall be made to the Clerk of the Circuit Court unless directed differently by the supervising agent or the court.
- \_\_\_\_\_ J) The Defendant is ordered to maintain full time employment while on probation or be enrolled in a full time study or trade program. During periods of unemployment said Defendant shall participate in a job search program as directed by the supervising agent and submit proof of efforts to locate employment.
- \_\_\_\_\_ K) The Defendant shall submit to random drug and alcohol screening at the discretion of the supervising agent or his/her designee. Refusal to submit to requested urine or breath tests shall constitute a violation of probation. Any positive alcohol or drug test (assuming no valid prescription) will be considered probable cause to conduct a search and seizure of the Defendants person, vehicle, residence or any other area the Defendant may be occupying.
- \_\_\_\_\_ L) The Defendant shall not possess or use any firearms or deadly weapons during the probation period, due to safety concerns for the supervising agent. All firearms shall be stored in a non-common living area if the Defendant is residing in a residence not owned by the Defendant.
