

PART 34 – LARCENY AND RELATED OFFENSES

LARCENY-DEFINITIONS

"Bailee" means a person other than the owner of property who rightfully possesses property.

"Deprive" means:

1. To withhold property of another permanently or for so extended a period as to appropriate a major portion of its economic value or with intent to restore only upon payment of reward or other compensation; or
2. To dispose of the property so as to make it unlikely that the owner will recover it.

"Public servant" means any officer or employee of government, including legislators and judges, and any person participating as juror, witness, advisor, consultant or otherwise, in performing any activity which a public servant is legally authorized to undertake on behalf of a government.
