Board of Professional Responsibility

The purpose of this board is to conduct hearings in lawyer disciplinary matters. The board may administer reprimands in less serious instances or misconduct. For more serious or repeated misconduct, it may recommend imposition of public discipline to the Wyoming Supreme Court.

Character & Fitness Committee

The purpose of this committee is to assist the Board of Law Examiners in conducting such character and fitness investigations and hearings regarding applicants for admission to practice law as it deems necessary. Court Rules require the committee to include one non-lawyer with special training in substance abuse, mental health, financial management or another area of value to the assessment of good moral character and fitness to practice law of applicants.

	Fee Arbitrators Fee arbitrators serve as hearing officers in proceedings brought pursuant to the Wyoming Fee Arbitration Rules. Disputes involving less than \$10,000 are heard and decided by a single arbitrator. Disputes involving \$10,000 or more are decided by a 3-arbitrator panel, one of whom shall be a nonlawyer. Appointment: Wyoming Supreme Court Term: Three years
