ORDER SETTING INITIAL CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE

An Initial Case Management Conference (ICMC) will be held in this court on the ____ day of _____ 2023 at _____ a.m., or as soon thereafter as the court may reach the same.

The ICMC will be held in-person in the courtroom unless a party arranges at least three business days in advance of the hearing to appear by telephone or by digital video.

The attorneys who will actually conduct the trial, or parties who will be representing themselves (pro se litigants), are required to be present. To assure just and expeditious disposition of the case, the attorneys or pro se litigants are required to be thoroughly familiar with the case prior to the management conference. All Disclosures as required by Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure for Circuit Courts, Rule 5 shall be completed prior to the case management conference. Any objections to the adequacy of the information provided in the initial and supplemental disclosures shall be made at the ICMC. The parties are also encouraged to stipulate in writing as to as many facts as possible prior to the ICMC and bring the stipulation to the ICMC.

The parties shall be prepared to discuss discovery. Discovery beyond the limits imposed by Rule 8 will only be allowed upon good cause demonstrated to the Court at the ICMC.

The parties shall be prepared to discuss the need for and a date that expert testimony will be available for exchange per Rule 9.

The parties shall discuss whether the matter shall be tried to the Court or to a Jury. The parties shall have calendars available to discuss trial dates.

Should any attorney or pro se litigant fail to appear at the case management conference, an ex-parte hearing will be held and the appropriate sanction may be imposed.
